INTRODUCTION

This is not, in the main, a list of the Bodleian Library's large-scale OS holdings (the County Series), but a list of missing sheets. These aside, our holdings should be complete. For information on what the OS published in the County Series, and for county-by-county survey and revision dates, see the *OS Index Atlas* (reprinted by David Archer Maps: <http://www.david-archer-maps.co.uk>) and Richard Oliver's *OS Maps: A Concise Guide for Historians* (The Charles Close Society, London, 2005; ISBN 1-870-59824-5). The few lists of Bodleian holdings that are included below cover scales, series or revisions of the same era not covered by these two publications, for example the 1:1250s and various anomalous sheets.

Anomaly: Many 1901-03 revisions of the Belfast area are interleaved among 1st edn grids 52, 56, 57, 60, 61, 64, 65 (the 1894 originals).

CO. CARLOW:

Out of sequence: Grids 6 to 9, 14 to 16, & 20 to 26 are in boxes.

CO. CAVAN:

Out of sequence: Grids 31 to 44 are in boxes.

CO. CLARE:

Binding error: Clare 29_5 bound after 29_2.

CO. CORK:

Missing: 87_7 (c.1898).

Out of sequence: 34_10 and grid 61 are in boxes.

CO. DONEGAL:

Missing: 102_9, 102_14 (c.1905).

CO. DOWN:

Anomaly: Many 1901-03 revisions of the Belfast area are interleaved among 1st edn grids 1, 2, 5, 9 (the 1894 originals).

CO. DUBLIN:

Anomaly: Co. Dublin the only 1:2500 1st edn Ireland county to be mapped in parishes and, in Bodleian copies, in colour.

Out of sequence: Up to 1868, parish maps in the Dublin area stop short of central Dublin and refer us to the 1:1056 (5' / mile) town plans; but from the early 1870s the O.S. brought out mixed-parish 1:2500s for central Dublin, bound in the St. Catherine's parish vol.

Missing: Clontarf and Tully parishes (not in BL catalogue either).

Binding errors:

Out of sequence: Grids 1 to 9, 14 to 16, 22 to 43 are in boxes.

CO. GALWAY:

Anomaly: Colour: Grids in the east of Co. Galway in colour - 1, 2, 6,

7, 8, 18, 19, 20, 31, 32, 33, 45, 46, 47, 60, 61, 74, 88, 99, 100, 101, 108, 109, 118, 127 (as are adjoining Roscommon grids).

CO. KILDARE:

Out of sequence: Grids 15 (parts of) & 20 (parts of) are in boxes.

CO. KILKENNY:

Missing: 34_3 (c.1902).

KING'S COUNTY (later CO. OFFALY):

Out of sequence: Grids 12 to 14, & 18 to 42 are in boxes.

CO. LEITRIM:

Out of sequence: Grids 1 to 8, 13 to 16, & 20 to 38 are in boxes.

CO. LONDONDERRY (CO. DERRY):

Anomaly: At the end of the Londonderry 1:500 vol there are eight 1:2500 sheets (1870s, in colour) of 'The City of Londonderry and environs', on old Co. Londonderry sheet-lines, pre-dating the sheets in the 1:2500 1st edn binder.

CO. LONGFORD:

Out of sequence: Grids 6 to 27 are in boxes.

CO. LOUTH:

Out of sequence: Whole county in boxes.

CO. MAYO:

Missing: 70_2 (c.1897).

Binding errors: Mayo 31 grid bound 1, 2, 5, 6, 9, 10 (revision), 13 (revision), 15, 3, 7, 10 & 13 (originals), 11, 12, 14, 16.

CO. MEATH:

Binding errors: 9_16 bound after 9_10 ; 9_11 bound after 9_15.

Out of sequence: Grids 10 to 53 are in boxes.

CO. MONAGHAN:

Out of sequence: Grids 6 to 8 & 12 to 34 are in boxes.

QUEEN'S CO. (later CO. LAOIS):

Out of sequence: Grids 1 to 28 & 32 to 34 are in boxes.

CO. ROSCOMMON:

Out of sequence: Grids 3 to 24 are in boxes.

Anomaly: In colour are grids 26 to 30 (c.1890), 33 to 37, some of 38, and 39 to 56.

CO. DUBLIN:

Unlike OS GB, OSI did not use this scale much. We have fifty-three 1:1250 enlargements from 1:2500 of the Dublin area, 1930s: grids 3,5,14,15,17,18,19,22,23 (25-inch number plus a, b, c, d instead of NW,NE,SW,SE).

1:1056 enlargements from 1:2500

The preferred OSI enlargements scale. We have several hundred 1:1056 enlargements from 1:2500, of towns and villages, 1920s-30s. Unlike the G.B. 1:1250 enlargements, the OSI 1:1056 equivalents are centred on the towns and villages, so don't have 1:2500-based sheet-numbers, and none is partially revised. The only one we have an index to is

ADDITIONAL SHEETS:

Belfast. There are 62 1:1056 sheets in the 2-vol Belfast 1st edn; the 2nd edn (one-vol) is on the same sheet-lines but lacks revisions of the following (if indeed they were published): 4, 5, 8 to 11, 14 to 24, 26 to 31, 33 to 38, 42 to 44, 48 to 50, 54 to 56, 60. There are twenty-seven additional sheets (Upper Belfast or Belfast Extension) in a fourth vol: 1A to 1G, 6A, 25A, 32A, 32B, 52A, 57A, 57B, 63 to 67. The "A" sheets are new areas - e.g. 32A is a different area from 32. The fact that the random-seeming "A sheet" numbers are also the numbers missing from the 2nd edn suggests that the latter were not published.

OUT-OF-SEQUENCE:

Many towns are in multi-town vols, so some are not shelved alphabetically. Locations are in brackets in list above.

Ballinasloe was never bound; the four sheets (87_10, 87_20, 88_1, 88_11) are in drawer [C19:42 Ballinasloe (1)]; index in Ballina vol.

Dublin. There's an 1843 edn of the Dublin 1:1056 (5' / M) sheet 21 ("The Castle Sheet") bound after Co. Dublin 6" Sheet 18. The sheet 21 in the Dublin town-plan vol is "corrected to 1847".

BINDING-ERRORS:

Bray (Co. Wicklow) and Bangor (Co. Down) bound in red buckram as if they were E & W towns, but correctly shelved among Ireland binders.
